

Spring 2022 Internship: Algae and Art

Exploring the history, science, and art of seaweed

Description:

The Cheadle Center for Biodiversity and Ecological Restoration (CCBER) at UCSB is seeking **2 undergraduate students** who are interested in a hands-on opportunity to develop an educational display focused on the center's marine algae and seaweed collections. Students will **gain experience in science communication, interpretation, & design**. Students will work closely with Cheadle Center staff to learn about seaweed and the collections to develop new materials for a display case used in teaching and to inform visitors to the Cheadle Center about the collection.

Requirements:

This internship requires a **commitment of 3-4 hours per week to meet in person and the student's time will be compensated with a stipend**. A computer, tablet, or other personal device with a moderate to large screen that can connect to the internet.
